

AGREEMENT

on the establishment of the Kyrgyz Republic Universities National
Network «Green and Digital Universities»

Osh city

“16” May 2025

1. General Provisions

1.1. The partner universities of the Kyrgyz Republic, participants of the project 101126755 “Green and Digital Universities for Sustainable Development of Kyrgyzstan” of the Erasmus+ program (hereinafter referred to as GREENKG), henceforth collectively referred to as the “Parties”, conclude this agreement on the establishment of the National Network of Universities of the Kyrgyz Republic “Green and Digital Universities” (hereinafter referred to as the Network).

1.2. The Network is a national, open and voluntary platform for cooperation in the field of sustainable development, green economy, digital transformation and innovative technology.

1.3. The Network is guided by the principles and goals of the Sustainable Development Strategy of the Kyrgyz Republic for 2018-2040 and the National Development Program of the Kyrgyz Republic until 2026.

2. Goals and Objectives of the Network

2.1. The goals of the Network are:

- promotion of environmental and digital initiatives in the university environment;
- strengthening academic and scientific cooperation between domestic universities;
- development and implementation of joint projects in the field of sustainable development, green technologies and digital innovations;
- development of the teachers, researchers and students potential in the designated areas.

2.2. The main objectives of the Network include:

- ensuring the availability and joint use of the resource base and infrastructure of the Parties for the implementation of joint research and work;
- implementation of “Green and Digital University” model developed within the framework of the project;
- continuation of joint work in priority areas of the Network, after completion of the project;
- preparation and submission of joint applications for grants for further work on digitalization and greening of universities.
- greening of campuses and resource management (water, energy, waste);

- digitalization of administrative and educational processes;
- implementation of courses and programs on sustainable development, climate, artificial intelligence, Big Data and digital skills;
- conducting internships, seminars, trainings and research work based on green and digital offices created with the financial support of the project;
- publishing joint scientific research and reports on sustainable development.

3. Membership and Partnership

3.1. The accredited higher education institutions of the Kyrgyz Republic may become members of the Network.

3.2. New members are admitted based on the submission of an application and consideration at the general meeting of the Parties.

3.3. The Network welcomes the participation of partner organizations (government agencies, NGOs, research centers) in the status of observers or consultants.

3.4. The Network is open to other educational institutions of the Kyrgyz Republic, subject to the consent of the majority of Network participants.

3.5. The Parties have the right to involve third parties in the activities of the Network, including foreign scientific and educational organizations, as associate members of the Network.

4. Organizational Structure

4.1. The Network is governed as follows:

- The Network Council is the highest strategic decision-making body, consisting of two representatives from each university, and coordinates day-to-day activities, communications and administrative support.

- The Chairman of the Network Council is elected from among the Network's member rectors and is subsequently re-elected every 3 years.

- The Network Council meets at least once a year in accordance with the work plan it approves. If necessary, meetings may be held unscheduled. Meetings may be held via video and/or audio conferencing.

- The main function of the Council is to develop the main principles of cooperation and make conceptual decisions aimed at achieving the goals of the Network.

- A meeting of the Network Council has a quorum if at least 2/3 (two thirds) of the active members of the Network participate in the decision-making.

- Decisions of the Network Council are made by a majority of votes registered to participate in the meeting of the Network Council.

- Working groups are created by specific topics (for example, “Green Campus”, “Digital Learning”, “Energy”, etc.).

4.2. The official languages of the Network are Kyrgyz, Russian and English.

5. Financing of the Network’s Activities

5.1. Financing is provided by:

- GREENKG project;
- voluntary membership fees;
- international grant programs;
- targeted funding from universities, foundations and private donors.

5.2. Each Party independently bears the costs associated with its participation in the Network, unless otherwise provided by separate agreements.

5.3. The Agreement does not impose any property or financial obligations on the Parties that have signed it.

6. Legal Status and Jurisdiction

6.1. The Network is not a legal entity, unless otherwise agreed in the future.

6.2. The regulatory framework for the activities of the Parties within the Network are the legislation of the Kyrgyz Republic, the Agreement, the Network Development Plan, organizational agreements and contracts of the Network, as well as other contracts concluded by the Parties among themselves and with the third parties.

6.3. The rights to protected results of intellectual activity (developments, methods, utility models) created during the implementation of the Network’s work program within the framework of the Agreement are distributed in equal shares between the Parties that have received the corresponding results.

6.4. All disputes are resolved through negotiations. If resolution is impossible, it will be considered within the framework of the legislation of the Kyrgyz Republic.

7. Term and Termination of Agreement

7.1. The Agreement enters into force upon signing and is valid indefinitely.

7.2. Each Party has the right to withdraw from the Network by giving written notice 3 months in advance.

7.3. The Agreement may be revised and supplemented by mutual agreement of the Parties.

8. Final Provisions

8.1. The Agreement is made in ten copies in Kyrgyz, Russian and English, one copy for each partner university. All three texts have equal legal force.

8.2. The appendices and minutes of the meetings signed by the Parties are an integral part of the Agreement.


